



Schools Creative Competition Terms & Conditions

These Terms and Conditions (“Terms”) govern entry into “The Future Is Clean” competition conducted by Clean Up Australia Ltd (ABN 93 003 884 991) of Level 4, 233 Castlereagh Street, Sydney NSW 2000 (“Promoter”). By entering the Promotion, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms.

1. Promotion Details

Schools Creative Competition: The Future Is Clean

Promotion Period: Starts 9:00 AM on Sunday 1st February 2026 and ends 12:00 midnight on Tuesday 31st March 2026.

Draw/Judging Date: Judging will take place between 1 – 29 April 2026. The winner and runners up will be announced on the Clean Up Australia website (cleanup.org.au) on Tuesday 30th April 2026.

Note: All times referenced are in Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) unless otherwise specified.

2. Eligibility

- Entry is open to any school student between the ages of 4yrs - 18yrs attending and enrolled in a participating registered school for a Clean Up event between the dates Feb 1st, 2026, and March 31st, 2026. Entrants must be residents of Australia.
- Entrants under 18 must have parental/guardian/ teacher consent, and entries must be submitted via a supervising teacher via the Clean Up Australia website.
- Employees of the Promoter, its suppliers, agencies and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.

3. Entry Process

- Entry requirements will be detailed in the competition announcement and include:
 - Registering a Clean Up at your school;
 - Completing a digital entry form via cleanup.org.au;
 - Submitting images and written submissions.

- Entries received after the Entry Period will not be accepted.

4. Verification

- Clean Up Australia may verify the validity of entries and entrants.
- Proof of Clean Up event registration, identity, age, residency, and eligibility may be required.
- Clean Up Australia reserves the right to disqualify incomplete, ineligible, forged, or fraudulent entries.

5. Competition Type

- Game of Skill: Entries judged based on published criteria. Chance plays no part.

6. Prizes

Winning Prize: One design from either a primary or secondary school student will be awarded the Winning Prize which includes:

- The student's artwork applied to a Coles reusable bag available to shoppers across Australia in 2027.
- \$1,000 Coles gift card for the student's school

Runner-Up Prizes: Two runner-up designs will be selected: one primary school student design and one secondary school student design.

- Winners will be notified by phone or email during the judging period.
- Winners' names, name of the school and state, and an image of the winning design, may be published on cleanup.org.au, newsletters, or social media.
- If a winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, or does not claim their prize, Clean Up Australia may award the prize to another entrant.

9. Delivery of Prizes

- The Coles vouchers in the Prizes will be delivered within 15 business days of the winner providing their delivery details
- Prizes to students will be emailed to their School, care of the supervising teacher and/or school representative nominated in the competition entry form

10. Intellectual Property (Skill-Based Competitions)

- By submitting an entry, entrants grant the Promoter a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use, reproduce, publish, and communicate entry materials for promotional purposes.
