Eligible Entrants	Adults (educators) aged 18 years or over who register an eligible school Clean Up event.
Verification Procedures	To be eligible for the competition, an entrant must: • Be an eligible entrant under these Terms and Conditions. • Register a School Clean Up event (Early Learning, Primary or Secondary) via cleanup.org.au during the Entry Period , with the event scheduled to take place between 1 September 2026 and 31 October 2026 as part of the Great Spring Clean Up campaign. Each eligible registration will be automatically entered into the prize draw. Each eligible registration constitutes one (1) entry into the competition and will have an equal chance of winning. Clean Up Australia reserves the right to verify the validity of any registration and to disqualify any entrant who has submitted a false or misleading registration.
